Course Description

This course explores how the management accountant contributes to everyday functions such as planning, communication, controlling, coordination, and motivation. The course introduces the basic terminology of management accounting and provides practical examples of each concept. The course evaluates the structure of management accounting systems, and considers how the data produced in such systems can be used in the decision-making process; identifies and evaluates the social, behavioral, and cultural aspects of management accounting systems; describes the functions of accounting in business organizations and distinguishes between management and financial accounting; explains the issues relating to cost classification and applies the procedures of absorption and marginal costing in allocating and apportioning overhead costs, and in performing basic break-even analysis; and distinguishes between long-term and short-term management decisions in relation to budgeting.
