Course Description

This course provides an anthropological approach to art in public space by exploring the public sphere as a place of communication and contestation, transmission and transformation, and engagement and estrangement. Examining independent and institutional art practices, from the apparent “vandalism” of graffiti to the authorized projects of contemporary public art, it explores the social, political, and economic debates which these practices both implicitly intersect with and overtly investigate. The course focuses on the concept of public and publicity, community, and the commons. It also includes guest lectures and workshops by artists as well as explorations of particular exhibitions and events in a local context.
