#### **Course Description**

This course provides both methodological and theoretical guidance for doing critical ethnography in Southeast Asia. The course systematically teaches the fundamentals of practicing ethnography in Southeast Asia and considers philosophical-theoretical, disciplinary and ethical issues underpinning each stage of the ethnographic process. Different forms of ethnographic texts on Southeast Asia (including films) are introduced to teach how to critically evaluate ethnographies. The course includes an ethnographic research project.
