This course examines basic concepts, theories, and methods in the comparative analysis of political systems. Participants study research on topics such as political regimes, actors, and procedures (dictatorship, democracy, political parties, NGOs, elections), civil society, crises and legitimization, capitalism and democracy, and direct democracy. International relations are examined with regard to theories and issues of war and peace as well as with a special focus on the European Union and its intersectionality between international relations and comparative politics.
