### **Course Description**

This course provides an overview of the voluntary and involuntary journeys, life experiences, as well as the general culture of Africans in the Diaspora. It discusses some of the surviving African cultural elements in the Americas, and analyzes certain cultural and political coping/resistance strategies.
