Course Description

This course introduces students to current issues relating to corporations with a focus primarily on US corporate law. The course includes an exploration of the basic corporate governance structure provided by corporate law as well as the effects of changes to the basic capital structure of the corporation and of government shareholding on corporate governance dynamics. The course then focuses on recent debates concerning corporate “personhood,” including whether corporations should enjoy constitutional rights, such as free speech, or be subject to criminal prosecution and whether corporations should be required to behave in a socially responsible manner.
