This courses covers 4-5 Jane Austen's novels—NORTHANGER ABBEY, PRIDE AND PREJUDICE, EMMA, MANSFIELD PARK (possibly also PERSUASION). Students consider the importance of women as readers, and, in terms of literary history, the detail that Jane Austen is an almost exact contemporary of Wordsworth and Coleridge.
