Course Description

This course covers the turn in psychology, which emphasized the significance of the cultural, the contextual, and social interaction in understanding the individual. First, the course works with different ideas of how we are to understand and work with context. Through this, participants learn to relate to and judge these different terms' and concepts' strengths and weaknesses. Following this, the course works with different theoretical directions and their accompanying empirical work using these understandings of context. This includes, among others, critical psychology, practice theory, complex systems theory, socio-cultural theory, discourse psychology, position theory, situated learning and narrative social constructivism. The seminar touches upon themes such as the significance of context for social interaction, cognition, learning, education, praxis, participation, development, and identity. Further, upon initiative from the students, the course allows for discussion on how the themes relate to fields of interest to the students.
