This course introduces students to a number of major similarities and differences between English, Germanic languages, Romance languages, Mandarin Chinese, Cantonese, Japanese and other languages of interest. The course explores the common properties and systematic syntactic variation of human languages under the Principles & Parameters model (P&P) of the generative syntax.
