Course Description

Students often experience politics as a remote practice of the elite. This course teaches students how politics is present in everyday life, the impact of everyday politics on traditional politics, and how political authorities contribute to everyday politics. The course explores how politics is embedded in the daily lives of individuals and communities. Students examine the manifestations of everyday politics (engagement, resistance, social media, culture, identity, symbols, emotions, values, political practices) and how everyday politics influences the formal and informal practices of politics.
