Course Description

This course introduces students to the history, institutions, workings, and future of the European Union (EU). The first half of the course is dedicated to describing the most important EU institutions, including the Commission, the Council, the Parliament, and the ECB, also in their relationships with the member states. The second half of the course examines some of the fundamental challenges facing the EU as it seeks to become more competitive, to integrate further existing states into a fuller political economic Union, to enlarge its membership, and to develop a viable common global trade policy and a more effective and coherent common foreign policy. The course also examines the political, economic, and social convulsions, still evolving in many cases, resulting from the European financial crisis of recent years. The course analyzes, with the benefit of firsthand experience, the conflict between the traditional theoretical aims of the European Union and the complex practical political reality of achieving those aims. To this end a number of case-studies are analyzed and debated during the course.
