### **Course Description**

This course is split into two parts, A and B. Students must take both parts. Part A covers the topic exam and Part B covers the language exam. This course covers 4-5 Jane Austen's novels—NORTHANGER ABBEY, PRIDE AND PREJUDICE, EMMA, MANSFIELD PARK (possibly also PERSUASION). The focus is on details, of spelling and punctuation, of idioms and idiolects, of social customs and regulations. Students consider the importance of women as readers, and, in terms of literary history, the detail that Jane Austen is an almost exact contemporary of Wordsworth and Coleridge.
