This course examines the Spanish legal system and procedural and litigation law. Topics discussed include: methods of solving legal conflicts; jurisdiction and jurisdiction exclusivity; the model of the judiciary, institutions of government, their composition and powers; the Spanish judicial organization and the distribution of competences between courts; the status and functions of prosecutors, lawyers, and employees of the justice administration; due process and legal protections; the constitutional guarantees and statute of judges and magistrates; the costs and expenses of the judicial process. NOTE: This course is the same as LEGST 102, but taught in English.
