Course Description

The course consists of a brief repetition, a deepening, and an extension of the microeconomic topics that have been discussed during the first year microeconomics course. New elements in the course are game theory, bargaining, auctions, choice under uncertainty, asymmetric information, and general equilibrium theory.
