## **Course Description**

This course provides a study of modern fashion design. Specific focus is placed on how fashion accommodates and enhances the wearer's social, physical, and psychological well-being and the impact of emerging global fashion on individuals and society. Topics include problems of global sourcing and fast fashion; ethical business practice in production and consumption (e.g., sweatshops, child labor, animal treatment, etc.); environmental impact, eco-friendly fashion, and repurposing textile waste; wearable interface and smart clothing for enhanced human well being; and human-centered design for specific users' safety and performance.
