Students also strengthen their ability to read and critically evaluate empirical research articles in developmental psychology and to articulate their ideas clearly in both written and spoken form. Topics include Early Moral Foundations: Infants and Toddlers, Fairness and Distributive Justice, Us and Them: Group Psychology, Social Influence: Reputation, Conformity, and Group Rituals, Moral Emotions, Current Issue in Developmental Science: Replicability, Moral Reasoning, Punishment and Norm Enforcement, Alternative Responses to Transgressions, Moral Learning, Legitimacy and Legal Socialization, Lying and Dishonesty, Technology, Media, and Modern Moral Issues, and Current Issue in Developmental Science: Generalizability.
