Course Description

This course is based on the idea that important cultural meaning is created through visual media. Students learn practical techniques of visual analysis and are encouraged to apply them in ways that consider relevant sociological and media debates and theories around visibility in contemporary culture. Students examine race, gender, class, dis/ability, and age through close analysis of images found in social media, television, print media, film, and music video. The course also introduces students to visual research methodologies. This course is particularly useful for students wishing to undertake dissertation projects that interrogate or work with visual media.
