Course Description

This course introduces main themes in the history of modern China through an examination of political, social, economic, and cultural development of China since 1900 with emphasis on the development of Chinese nationalism and on the rise, theory, and practice of Chinese communism. In addition to the above macro history perspective, this course provides a more microperspective to modern Chinese history. Topics include Taiyuan and Ruian, 1905; Beijing, 1919; urban life in 1930s China; Guangzhou 1927; Nanjing regime, 1927-1937; new China, 1950-1958; Cold War in 1950s China; the Great Leapforward; the Cultural Revolution; Deng Era; and Beijing, 1989.
