## Course Description

This course is an exploration of Latin America, a world that includes Central and South America, from historical, geo-political, economic perspectives as well as through cultural ones to include food, music, gender, race, and class. The course seeks to come to an understanding of the experiences and processes that have shaped the region. It provides students with a global vision of the Latin American reality.
