## Course Description

This course provides a survey of Spanish literature in the nineteenth century. It examines works of poetry, theater, and narrative during four major movements, taking into account cultural context and important authors of the period. Topics include: historical and social context of nineteenth century Spanish literature; romanticism and its origins; romantic poetry, works by José de Espronceda, Gustavo Adolfo Bécquer and Rosalía de Castro; romantic theater, "Don Juan Tenorio" by José Zorrilla; journalism and Costumbrismo, works by Mariano José de Larra; historical novel; serial novels, realism, works by Benito Pérez Galdós; naturalism, LOS PAZOS DE ULLOA by Emilia Pardo Bazán; literary criticism (Leopoldo Alas); realist theater and poetry; literary trends at the end of the century.
