The course is concerned with the following main areas: general study of the nature of proprietary interests in land (legal and equitable) including the doctrines of tenure and estates, the concept and physical limits of land, doctrine of accession (fixtures), co-ownership, as well as an introduction to native title; study of the Torrens Title system (that is the statutory scheme of registration of land interests) which involves a study and analysis of the Land Title Act 1994 (Qld); and general study of the nature of certain proprietary interests in land including leases, easements and mortgages.
