### **Course Description**

This language course focuses on the following grammar topics at the advanced intermediate level: various grammar points known to represent zones of resistance even among advanced learners (observation of certain forms of negation, determination of complex nominal syntagms, use of prepositions and idiomaticism, etc.); the main aspects of the French complex phrase. The course also covers academic communication in French. This course is intended for students who wish to learn about writing and oral presentation in the context of university work. It addresses issues such as the structuring of academic discourse, norms of enunciation, verbal use of time, logical groupings and expression of thought, modalities and objectivity. In this course, students learn the rules to follow and the pitfalls to avoid so that their academic communication is clear and effective.
