Course Description

This course is an introduction to the sociological study of lifestyles and social relations in urban spaces. The first part of the course covers structural contexts of opportunities and the evolution of approaches and paradigms in urban sociology. This part of the course centers on two questions: how does sociology understand the morphology of urban spaces and their constraints; is it possible to track social effects related to the

distribution/cohabitation/segregation of different social and ethnic groups. Contemporary debates related to urban population dynamics and to relations between groups and individuals are highlighted. The second part of the course is about sociological methodology. A preliminary introduction to methods of urban ethnography helps students design and implement a minisurvey in three different types of urban spaces.
