### **Course Description**

The course enables non-Tamil-speaking beginners to achieve competence in understanding and using basic Tamil, both its spoken and written forms. The emphasis is on conversational Tamil and its practical use at the level of everyday discourse and on written Tamil and its use at the beginners' level. The course presents listening, reading, writing, and speaking initially through a Romanized script; then covers orthographic system of Tamil and the essential aspects of Tamil grammar. By the end of the course, students should be able to write and read small texts using the Tamil orthographic system and have basic listening and speaking skills in Tamil. Assessment: tutorials, tests and quizzes, projects and assignments.
