#### **Course Description**

The labor migration from Southern European countries to Germany, which started in the mid-1950s, had an important socio-economic and sociocultural impact on the countries' societies and influenced their film culture. German filmmakers began to feature the difficult lives of 'questworkers' in films such as Rainer Werner Fassbinder's Katzelmacher (1969). In the 1990s, second - and third - generation Turkish-German directors such as Fatih Akın and Thomas Arslan marked the end of the so-called 'guestworker' cinema' and started to create a transnational and diasporic cinema featuring a culturally hybrid Germany. Berlin (especially Kreuzberg) has always been one of the favorite settings in all of these migration movies. The transformation of Berlin's first 'guestworker ghettos' to culturally hybrid urban districts over the course of 60 years is very well reflected in all of these cinema cultures. This interdisciplinary course crosses and connects the academic fields of migration studies, film studies, and cultural studies. In the first part of the course, we will explore how migration, immigrants, and diasporas are represented in cinema. The second part of the course then gets more specific and we approach the representation of Berlin in these migration movies.
