## Course Description

This course is a work experience placement, which students undertake in an art-related work environment in London. Students examine established and emerging art world careers, together with cultural and management issues related to the creative sector. Part of the class is a range of sessions designed to develop and enhance students' professional skills, including training on wider employability skills, such as interview skills, networking, and communication. Students are introduced to contemporary management models for commercial and non-commercial practices through theory, case studies, and practical work. The course prepares students for a wide range of careers in the art world, wider creative sector, or for further study.
