## Course Description

This course is the first series in intermediate corporate financial management and aims to develop an understanding of the concepts, processes, and tools implemented in a business enterprise for financial management. The course covers: (i) introduction of finance; (ii) financial statement analysis; (iii) time value of money; (iv) portfolio selection: concepts of risks and returns and the capital asset pricing model (CAPM); (v) financing decisions, and (vi) capital budgeting decisions.
