Topics include early formation - the family as precursor?; onset and maintenance in adolescence; the role of place and community in offending; understanding recidivism; the impact of imprisonment - living with conviction; pathways to desistance; models of desistance; desistance and the criminal justice system; influencing the life-course: models of intervention; and forms of intervention in Ireland.
