Course Description

This course covers historical and contemporary concepts and techniques relating to non-objective painting. Painting is addressed in its history and as a category of contemporary art. It is broadly defined as an extended practice with a broad range of material, spatial and intellectual possibilities. In the course a variety of these approaches are explored through focused and self-initiated projects.
