Course Description

This course introduces Taiwanese literature, film, and culture on a national and international level. It provides an overview of the basics of literary and film history in Taiwan, providing an opportunity to read literary works in English translation as well as watch movies by Taiwanese cultural producers.

Engagement with these selected literary works and films will provide insights into fundamental issues and keywords such as history, place, gender, and migration.

The course aims to refine students' abilities to critically analyze and write about literature and film, as well as to develop a better understanding of Taiwanese literature and culture from the Japanese colonial period to the contemporary era. Class weekly meetings are divided into two parts: the first 50 minutes is devoted to lecture and the second 50 minutes is devoted to discussion.
