### **Course Description**

This course examines attention research and theory from an individual differences perspective. Students learn about a wide range of factors that can influence the ability to focus and maintain attention. Topics covered include the relationship between IQ, cognitive control and attention; attentional effects of individual differences in perception; age-related changes in attention; mind wandering; attentional biases associated with depression, addiction, and anxiety; clinical syndromes associated with attention problems (e.g. Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder). This course also covers key measures and methods used, and provides training in the critical analysis of research studies in the field.
