The course also allows the student to get acquainted with the production of primary data. The approach is multimethodological, and it focuses on the study of political elites. The first part of the course is devoted to qualitative methodologies, while the remaining part deals with more quantitative approaches to research in political science. The sessions are designed for students who have no prior knowledge and/or background in data analysis or research methods.
