Course Description

This course surveys the processes and institutions of Spanish politics. The topics discussed are political participation, voting, interest groups, parliamentarism vs. presidentialism, and two-party vs. multi-party systems. It examines the roles of the monarchy, the Supreme Court, the constitution, the relation of judicial and legislative power, and the shifting authority relations between central and autonomous governments in Spain. The course also reviews the developments of the European Union and its institutions, theories of integration, and the challenges inherent in the creation of a supranational political regime.
