## **Course Description**

This course examines the grotesque style, a recurrent feature of American literature, by focusing on fiction works from the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. An analysis of a selection of grotesque American fiction also allows a study of the reasons for the use of the grotesque and the role it plays.
