## Course Description

The purpose of this course is to give students the ability to communicate in Japanese at an advanced level. The course is designed for students who have completed at least three to four semesters of formal training (no less than 300 hours) at the college level. Students are expected to possess the ability to read and write simple essays and communicate smoothly in everyday situations. Students improve their comprehensive Japanese language skills through discussion with peer students and presentations about Japanese culture and society. To develop reading and listening comprehension skills, students will read and listen to texts about Japanese culture and society.
