Course Description

This course is designed to study and review the global efforts to pursue sustainable development. Such efforts have developed the concrete three pillars (Poverty Reduction/Environmental Sustainability/Social Protection) of sustainable development. Especially, the United Nations (UN) has led to establish sustainable development knowledge and capacity for policy-makers, bilateral and multilateral agencies and civil society with local partners in developing countries.
