Course Description

This seminar introduces the concept of epistemic injustice, when one is wronged in their capacity as a knower. Then, newer concepts, such as testimonial smothering, wilful hermeneutical ignorance, gaslighting, and epistemic exploitation, are considered before conducting application case studies.
