Course Description

The course provides an analysis of social psychology with a focus on groups and collective behavior. It is organized into four principal themes: groups and collective behavior; intra-group structures and processes; intergroup relationships; collective behavior and social movements. Specific topics include group formation; communication, leadership, conflict, and decision making within groups; identity, social structure, and intergroup behavior; majority influence and the active minority; social networks and new technologies; the individual and the crowd; the masses phenomena and emergency situations; collective action (protests and violence); mobilization of individuals in social movements and collective identity; and the effects of social movements.
