This course introduces the key issues and debates in the economics of globalization. Concepts and models from international economics are blended with historical analysis to provide an overview of the unfolding process of globalization over the long-term and the economic and political economy factors underlying that evolution. The course also covers specific (country) case studies with the impact of globalization on issues such as poverty, income inequality and the environment. It takes the interdisciplinary analytical framework, drawing not only in in economics but also political science, and business strategy to illustrate a multi-faceted feature of ongoing globalization.
