Course Description

This course provides basic knowledge of politics and society of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK; North Korea). This course is a mixture of area studies and international relations, particularly focusing on North Korea as a case study. Topics include DPRK political systems, governance, and economy; international sanctions and their impact, nuclear development, human rights, media and information control, and the future of the Korean Peninsula. Based on basic information of internal dynamics of North Korea, students are expected to search for motivations to study further issues regarding North Korea.
