### **Course Description**

This course is dedicated to better understanding the evolution of theatrical art in Europe from antiquity to the 20th century. The course starts by examining the origins of theater in ancient Greek and Roman society, followed by medieval theater and theater of the Italian, English, and Spanish Renaissance. It then studies French theater from the 17th century to the 19th century and finally, takes a look at European theater up to the 20th century.
