Course Description

This course introduces students to the critical potential of "everyday lived experience" as a radically different approach to psychological research and practice that provides a link between psychology and social theory.

Introduction to psychology of everyday lived experience; concepts such as lived experience, voice, values, subject position, participation; ethnography of lived experience as researching with the other; case studies such as children living in a debt economy, the everyday experience of being a migrant, digital technology and the transformation of everyday living, everyday caring, etc. Case studies vary from year to year.
