## Course Description

This course covers the purpose, methodological aspects, and critical issues within the fields of comparative and international education. Students will examine current trends in these areas, including international large-scale assessments (ILSAs) such as the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) and the Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS), coordinated by the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) and the International Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement (IEA). The core themes and implications of these ILSAs for education will be a key focus of the course.

Additionally, selected themes, such as culture and learning will be briefly covered, providing a comprehensive overview of the diverse factors influencing education worldwide. The course aims to sharpen students' analytic and research skills while cultivating independent and comparative insights into education on an international scope.
