Course Description

This course covers the purpose, methodological aspects, and critical issues within the fields of comparative and international education. Students will examine currents trends in these areas, including international large-scale assessments (ILSAs) such as the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) and the Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS), coordinated by the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) and the International Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement (IEA).
