It covers cultural and linguistic issues of the Baroque period, as well as literary theory and textual commentary of the time; lyric poetry; the Renaissance, Mannerism, and the Baroque; conceptismo and culteranismo; the picaresque novel; theater in the seventeenth century; didactic literature; Cervantes. Topics and readings may vary by semester and course instructor.
