This course is for students at an intermediate to advanced level of French. The oral part of the course (intermediate) helps students understand the main points of broadcasted programs, give oral presentations in various types of discourse such as informative, narrative, and argumentative, as well as participate in a debate and work on a group project. The written part of the course expects students to understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts, and recognize implicit meaning. Students learn to express themselves fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions; to use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic, and professional purposes; and to produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organizational patterns, connectors, and cohesive devices.
