The written part of the course expects students to understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts, and recognize implicit meaning. Students learn to express themselves fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions; to use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic, and professional purposes; and to produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organizational patterns, connectors, and cohesive devices.
