Course Description

This course develops students' knowledge and understanding of international business. It provides a deep contextualization of contemporary issues and debates within international business. The course explores how the world economy is changing and how international businesses are deeply embedded in a complex web of multi-scalar, multi-form and a multi-causal series of relationships. Drawing on theoretical constructs from a variety of perspectives and disciplines, the course aids the students' understanding of why and how businesses internationalize, and what happens as a consequence of these complex processes. The course also explains globalization, trade theory and the role businesses can play in alleviating poverty.
