## Course Description

Secondary prevention emphasizes early detection and timely intervention through disease screening, health checkups, and identification of pre-clinical conditions. Tertiary prevention addresses limiting disability, preventing complications, and supporting recovery through medical treatment, psychological support, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and long-term care.
