Particular attention is paid to the interplay between ideological frameworks, social structures, and cultural production. In addition to lectures, the course includes seminar sessions designed to strengthen students' analytical and written expression skills. These sessions provide training in core academic practices such as textual commentary and argumentative essay writing.
